Consul General of Israel to the Midwest

Consul General Orli Gil assumed her post at the Consulate General of Israel to the Midwest in late July, 2008. She is a career diplomat who has served in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for twenty two years. Her previous posts and positions have included Consul for Academic Affairs for the United States at the Consulate General of Israel in New York , where she was in charge of all activities relating to Israel on college campuses throughout the country. During her years with the Ministry in Jerusalem, Gil has served in the North American, the Public Affairs, and the Palestinian Affairs Divisions. She has also served in the Bureau of the Director General of the Ministry. For three years Gil was the Deputy Chief of Mission at the Embassy of Israel in Oslo, Norway. Prior to assuming her position as the current Consul General of Israel to the Midwest, Gil was in the Division of International Organizations as the Director, UN specialized organizations which include UNESCO (United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization), WHO World Health Organization and other NGOs (nongovernmental organizations).
